



Site use by people with disabilities

The OFDT site has been adapted to make it easier to be used by people with disabilities.

A site plan is available at the top right of each page of the website, under the search engine, to enable you to easily orient yourself in the first three structural levels.

It is possible to increase font size using the "Increase font size" button present on each website page. This is at the upper right of the pages, except for the home page, in which it is located at the bottom right. It is demonstrated in this visual:



Moreover, there is replacement text for each of the site's images to make it easier to read the pages when being used by a text-based browser or a screen reader (Lynx, JAWS).

Along the same lines, each website page has avoidance links making the page content easy to access from the menu or the search engine.
